They are certified as an "Okayama Organic Pesticide-Free Produce" establishment which adheres to stricter standards than national regulations. They recommend their richly flavored keema curry, made with an original blend of aromatic spices.

Koeido specializes in Kibi Dango, a signature souvenir from Okayama prefecture. The Kurashiki store is situated at the entrance to the Bikan Historical Area—known for its white-walled streets, rickshaws, and boats crossing the Kurashiki River. The building repurposed with traditional renovation techniques is a Meiji-era (1868-1912) townhouse embodying the theme "Museum of Time" blending seamlessly into the picturesque surroundings. In recent years, the soft and chewy texture of Kibi Dango has become immensely popular with international visitors. Vegan-friendly and Halal-certified options are also available, ensuring everyone can enjoy this Okayama tradition.

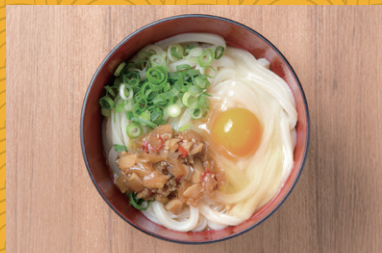

1 Kurashiki Station Tourist Information Center



Located within the information center at the gateway to Kurashiki, we offer a QuietSpace open to all. 2 Kurashikikan



Constructed in 1917 in the Bikan Historical Area, this Western-style building used to be the Kurashiki Town Hall. Now registered as a National Tangible Cultural Property, this iconic landmark is currently used as a tourist information center and free rest area. On the second floor, there is space for prayer.

3 Kojima Station Tourist Information Center



The information desk at Kojima Station offers a partitioned QuietSpace. Though simple in setup, our staff are on hand to ensure you can pray comfortably and without distraction. We warmly welcome Muslim visitors and anyone in need of a quiet moment.

4 Denim Lodge & Nest



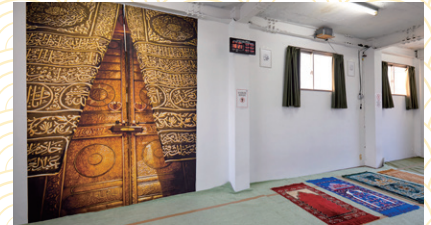

5 Washuzan Rest House



A scenic tourist hub with breathtaking views of the Great Seto Bridge, including a dedicated QuietSpace for prayer. A Turkish specialty shop located along the picturesque streets of the Bikan Historical Area. Opened in 2009, the store is a treasure trove of vibrant Turkish carpets, lamps, ceramics, etc., all carefully selected by the Muslim owner and beautifully displayed to captivate visitors.

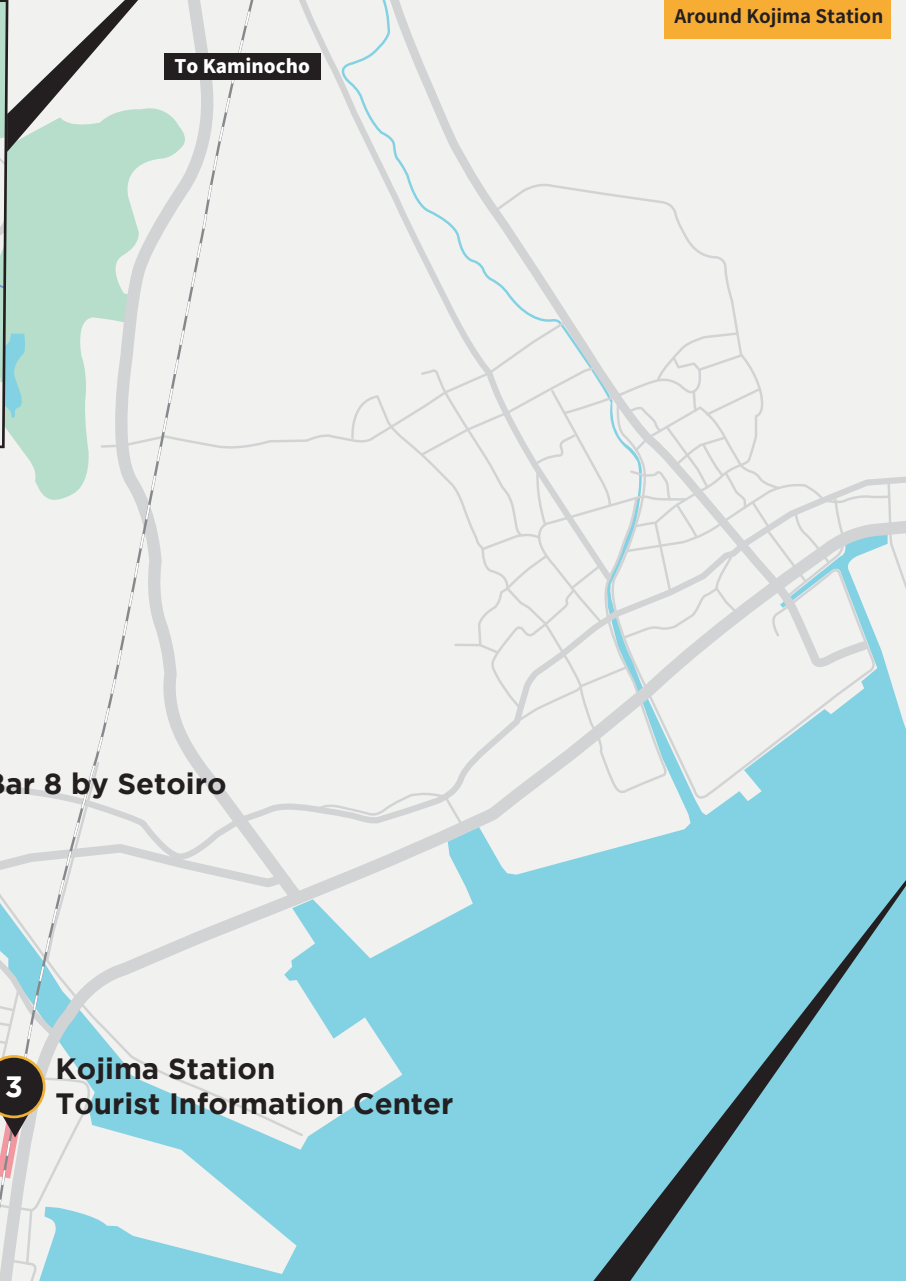
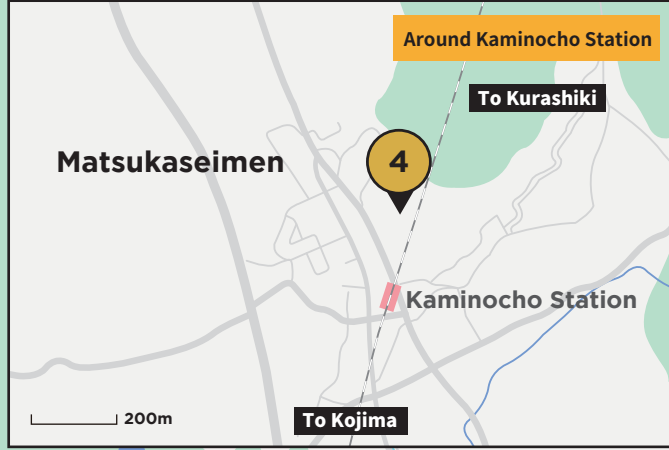

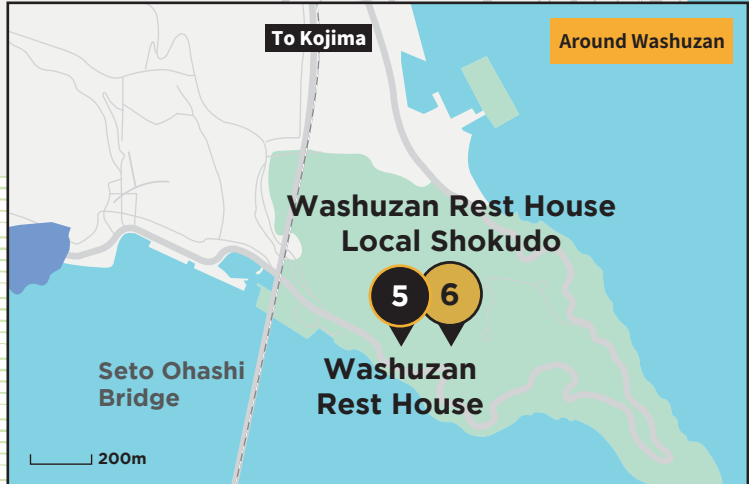
